Detrauma is a brand new mental health app designed to deliver trauma (PTSD) treatment to people without access to a therapist. 1 billion survivors suffer from PTSD.

Project Description

For our German market entry you will assist us successfully navigate the [DiGA process](#). You will join us completing the necessary steps and requirements including product development, clinical studies, pilot marketing, regulatory compliance.

Tasks include liaising with product design and engineering to build DiGA-relevant features into the app, establishing partnerships with research institutions (hospitals), scoping clinical studies, filing grant applications, consulting with the Bundesinstitut für Arzneimittel und Medizinprodukte (BfArM), recruiting test users, collecting data on treatment effectiveness, submitting the DiGA directory application, calculating appropriate pricing.

- Time commitment: 20 hours / week; can evolve into full-time employment upon graduation
- Pay: €1,000.00 per month
- Location: office is in Potsdam Babelsberg; we also support remote working (we will provide G-Suite account)
